2024 Theme – Finding Freedom: Family

Across the world millions of people live in fear for themselves, their family, their community, and their way of life. War and violence, political and religious persecution, natural disasters, and the effects of climate change are seriously impacting many of the world's people. The United Nations Refugee Agency (UNHCR) states that at the end of 2022 108.4 million people worldwide were forcibly displaced because of these events.

Throughout history there have been refugees, people forced to flee their homes and their country. Increased violence and wars, political and religious intolerance along with worldwide population growth has seen the number of people seeking refuge and asylum grow exponentially in the last 100 years.

Many refugees and asylum seekers are finding it increasingly difficult to find a safe and permanent haven where individuals and families can live without fear and be accepted as worthy contributors to their new home.
